

### Simple design for a relaxing time





### Ichie•Lounge

Agora Tokyo Ginza 1F: Seats 26

Hours: Open 24 hours

Named after the phrase ichigo ichie, which originates from the tea ceremony and means a once-in-a-lifetime encounter to be cherished, the Ichie•Lounge offers guests a place to take a break. Pour yourself a bowl of matcha powdered green tea from the Tea Pot, or sip on a delicious cup of coffee—we have a selection of drinks for all guests to enjoy.

The lounge also features a Machigokoro town map of Ginza, which has been carved into a panel on the wall. This map is designed to deepen your enjoyment of Ginza. Staff and locals who know the town well can recommend places of interests, and guests can pinup the areas they have visited and enjoyed.



## Activities

### Hama-rikyu Gardens

○Approx. 15 minutes on foot

It is one of the most famous gardens in Tokyo, having witnessed the changing landscape of the city for more than 360 years. The black pines, cherry blossoms, plum blossoms, and other seasonal flowers are some of the highlights that continue to delight visitors to the garden today.



### Tsukiji Honganji Temple

○Approx. 8 minutes on foot

It is one of the representative temples of the Honganji School of Jodo Shinshu in Tokyo, and is under the direct control of the Nishi Honganji Temple in Kyoto. The principal image of the temple is a standing Amida Nyorai statue said to have been carved by Prince Shotoku.
