## Activities

### Panasonic Museum

○Approx. 10 minutes by train and on foot

The Panasonic Museum consists of the "Konosuke Matsushita Museum," where visitors can learn about the business view and philosophy of the Panasonic founder; the "Hall of Manufacturing Ingenuity," where the DNA of Panasonic's unique approach to production is on exhibit; and "SAKURA HIROBA (Sakura Garden)," which is a park with 190 Someiyoshino cherry trees. All of these facilities will be freely opened for the general public to explore.

○Approx. 20 minutes by train and on foot

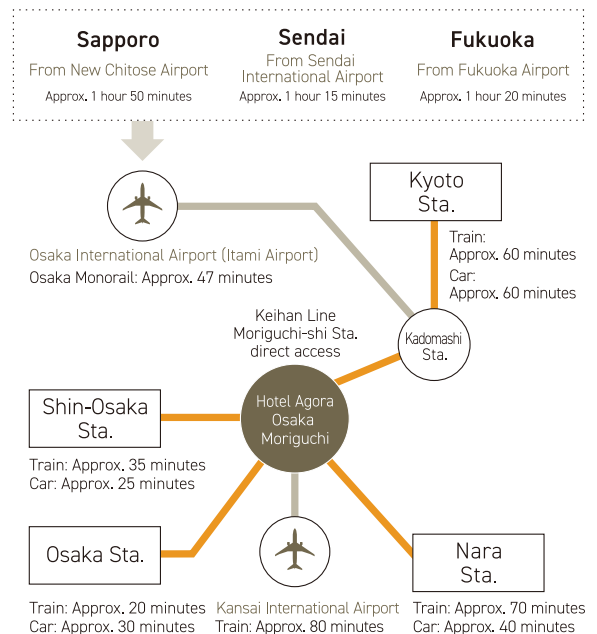

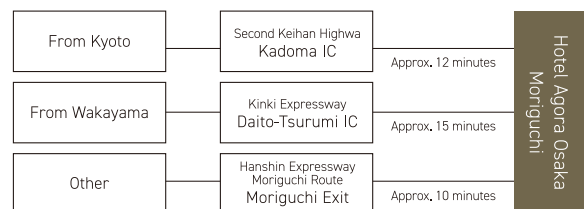
