ONE@Tokyo is very conveniently located a three-minutes' walk from Oshiage Station, which is famous for the Tokyo Sky Tree. It is easily accessible from both Haneda and Narita airports, with access to four train lines. Formerly, Oshiage was an industrial area in downtown Tokyo. World-renowned architect Kengo Kuma supervised both the interior and exterior designs, blending traditional wood framing with an industrial image, creating a contrast that is symbolic of the area. We will help you make one-of-a-kind discoveries and encounters in spots where the new cityscape intersects with the good old atmosphere that has existed since the Edo period.

○Approx. 15 minutes by train and on foot


